POOLS AND SPAS PLAN SUBMITTAL REQUIREMENTS

The following items are required to be completed prior to project acceptance for processing:

- 1. Plan check fees to be paid in full upon submittal (see Fee Schedule).
- 2. One copy of Building Permit Application, and Subcontractor's List, City of Irvine/OCFD/SCAQMD Screening Form (for commercial use only). Use black or blue ink <u>ONLY</u>.

An Encroachment Permit and Special Conditions form may be required if project is on a city street.

- 3. Two blueprints shall be submitted. All sheets must be signed by the registered engineer. (Three sets for commercial use.)
- 4. All applicable construction details shall be attached and referenced on the plans.
- 5. One copy of the engineer's structural calculations (if applicable).
- 6. Two copies of site plan showing dimensions from property line to pool/spa, structures, appliances, skimmers, overflow and other devices. (Three for commercial use.)
- 7. All piping location, material, and sizing shall be shown.
- 8. Data to include engineering calculations and/or manufacturer's data to qualify filtration turn-over-time to comply with Section 302 of the Uniform Swimming Pool Code shall be provided.
- 9. A statement on the plans shall show a special inspector certified by the City of Irvine for all gunite pools and spas be present and reports to the City during all such concrete placement.
- 10. A single permit is required for prefabricated portable spas installed entirely above grade. Application shall indicate approval number of the spa (i.e.; ICBO#, IAPMO#, U.L.#).
- 11. All pools/spas shall contain a separate skimmer or approved perimeter overflow. Discharge piping shall be connected directly to the pumped circulation piping flowing through the pool/spa filtration system.
- 12. Orange County Health Department approval will be required for all commercial uses.
