Procurement Organization

Decentralized Operations

- 24 County agencies/departments
- Each agency/department is responsible for their purchasing operations
- The County Purchasing Agent
 - Delegated purchasing authority
 - Over 250 Deputy Purchasing Agents



Office of the Purchasing Agent

Core Responsibilities

- Implement/enforce Board Policy & Establish Procedures
- Ensure a fair & ethical competitive process
- Provide Training & Certification to DPAs
- Conduct Compliance Reviews
- Implement Cooperative Contracts





General Information When Bidding

Read Solicitation Packages Carefully!

- Contact the appropriate DPA in charge of the solicitation.
- Bid awards may take up to thirty days to determine based on the complexity.
- Proposal awards take longer based on the Complexity & proposal evaluation process.

Submit Your Bid On Time. Late Bids may Not be Accepted!
