## OVERSIGHT BOARD RESOLUTION NO. 14-1


#### Abstract

A RESOLUTION OF THE OVERSIGHT BOARD OF THE SUCCESSOR AGENCY TO THE DISSOLVED IRVINE REDEVELOPMENT AGENCY APPROVING THE TRANSFER TO THE CITY OF IRVINE, AS HOUSING SUCCESSOR, OF THE FORMER REDEVELOPMENT AGENCY'S HOUSING ASSETS AS LISTED ON THE HOUSING ASSET LIST APPROVED BY THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA DEPARTMENT OF FINANCE


WHEREAS, as a result of the passage of Assembly Bill 26 from the 2011-12 first extraordinary session of the California Legislature ("ABx1 26 ") as modified by the California Supreme Court in the CRA v. Matosantos case, all redevelopment agencies in California, including the Irvine Redevelopment Agency ("RDA"), were dissolved on February 1, 2012; and

WHEREAS, Assembly Bill 1484 of the 2011-12 legislative session ("AB 1484") amended ABx1 26 (ABx1 26 and AB 1484, collectively, the "Dissolution Act"); and

WHEREAS, by adoption of Resolution No. 12-10 on January 10, 2012, the City Council of the City of Irvine ("City" or "City Council," as appropriate) became the Successor Agency ("Irvine Successor Agency") to the dissolved RDA pursuant to the Dissolution Act, at Health and Safety Code Section 34173; and

WHEREAS, by adoption of Resolution No. 12-11 on January 10, 2012, the City Council became the "housing successor" to the former RDA and elected to retain the housing assets of the former RDA pursuant to Dissolution Act, at Health and Safety Code Section 34176; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to the Dissolution Act, at Health and Safety Code Section 34176(a)(2), the housing successor was required to submit to the State of California Department of Finance ("DOF") not later than August 1, 2012, a "housing assets list" (also known as the "housing asset transfer form") which listed the housing assets of the former RDA elected to be retained by, and thus transferred to, the City as housing successor; and

WHEREAS, the City, as housing successor, prepared the Housing Asset List, dated July 31, 2012, a copy of which is attached hereto and incorporated herein as Exhibit "A" ("Housing Asset List"); and

WHEREAS, on August 1, 2012, the City, as housing successor, submitted the Housing Asset List, to the DOF; and

WHEREAS, the DOF, in a determination letter dated September 5, 2012, a copy of which is attached hereto and incorporated herein as Exhibit "B", approved the Housing Asset List; and

WHEREAS, the California State Controller's Office ("SCO") is conducting asset transfer review audits of the transfers of assets made by all former redevelopment agencies to their host cities or other public agencies during the period of January 1, 2011 through January 31, 2012, pursuant to the authority set forth in the Dissolution Act, at Health and Safety Code Section 34167.5; and

WHEREAS, the SCO has asserted that the oversight board is required to approve, by adoption of a resolution, the transfer of the former redevelopment agency's housing assets to the housing successor; and

WHEREAS, as part of its asset transfer review audits, the SCO auditors are asking for a copy of an oversight board resolution confirming oversight board approval to the transfer of the former redevelopment agency's housing assets to the housing successor; and

WHEREAS, the City and the Irvine Successor Agency have asserted to the SCO auditors that Oversight Board action ratifying and approving the foregoing described transfer of the former RDA's housing assets is not required because the transfer of the former RDA's housing assets to the City, as housing successor, occurred by operation of law pursuant to the terms of the Dissolution Act, at Health and Safety Code Section 34176(a)(1); and

WHEREAS, to avoid a dispute with the SCO, the Successor Agency is requesting that the Oversight Board adopt a resolution to confirm and ratify Oversight Board approval of the transfer of the former RDA's housing assets, as listed on the DOF-approved Housing Asset List, to the City as housing successor; and

WHEREAS, the Oversight Board desires to confirm and ratify its approval of the transfer of the former RDA's housing assets, as listed on the DOF-approved Housing Asset List, to the City as housing successor;

## NOW, THEREFORE, THE OVERSIGHT BOARD RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That the above Recitals are true and correct and are incorporated herein.

Section 2. The Oversight Board hereby approves and ratifies the transfer of the former RDA's housing assets, as listed on the DOF-approved Housing Asset List, to the City of Irvine as housing successor, as set forth in and confirmed by Exhibit A and Exhibit B attached hereto and by this reference incorporated herein, and hereby directs the transfer of those housing assets to the City as housing successor.

Section 3. The Oversight Board acknowledges that nothing in this Resolution shall act to modify, waive, discharge, or in any manner affect, any legal assertion made, or legal position taken, or to be made or taken in the future, by the Successor Agency or City or any other entity with respect to the subject matter of, or any of the matters set forth in, this Resolution.

Section 4. The Secretary shall certify to the adoption of this resolution. PASSED AND ADOPTED this $10^{\text {th }}$ day of January, 2014.
