City of Irvine

Irvine is located 40 miles southeast of Los Angeles and six miles from the ocean in Orange County, California. Incorporated as a Charter City in 1971 with a City Council-City Manager form of government, the first City Council revised the master plan developed by worldfamous architect William Pereira for the landowner, the Irvine Company; the Irvine General Plan is the basis for all development in the City.

Services provided by the City include animal control; building and safety regulation and inspection; general administrative services; planning and zoning; police; public facility and capital improvement construction; recreation and cultural programs; open space administration; street lighting; street maintenance; landscape maintenance; and transportation management.



FY 2014-15 Adopted General Fund Budget






Irvine Quick Facts
