A RESOLUTION OF THE OVERSIGHT BOARD TO THE SUCCESSOR AGENCY TO THE DISSOLVED IRVINE REDEVELOPMENT AGENCY OF THE CITY OF IRVINE, CALIFORNIA, APPROVING THE 2016 LOCAL AGENCY BIENNIAL NOTICE FOR THE OVERSIGHT BOARD'S CONFLICT OF INTEREST CODE AND DIRECTING THE SECRETARY TO FILE THE NOTICE WITH THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF IRVINE, CALIFORNIA, BY OCTOBER 1, 2016

WHEREAS, the Oversight Board to the Successor Agency to the dissolved Irvine Redevelopment Agency has been appointed pursuant to the provisions of Health & Safety Code Section 34179; and

WHEREAS, the Oversight Board is deemed a local entity for purposes of the Political Reform Act; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to the Political Reform Act and regulations promulgated thereunder by the Fair Political Practices Commission, on March 21, 2012, the Oversight Board adopted Resolution No. 2012-2, which adopted the FPPC model conflict of interest code by reference and with a minor amendment to Section 4; and the City Council, as the code reviewing body, approved the conflict of interest code on April 24, 2012, followed by ratification; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to the Political Reform Act and regulations promulgated thereunder by the Fair Political Practices Commission, on September 4, 2014, the Oversight Board adopted Resolution No. 2014-9, which determined that its conflict of interest code did not require amendments and directed the Board Secretary to file the 2014 Local Agency Biennial Notice with the City Council not later than October 1, 2014; and

WHEREAS, the Political Reform Act requires every local agency to review its conflict of interest code biennially, and to file a Local Agency Biennial Notice with the code reviewing body.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Oversight Board as follows:

<u>SECTION 1.</u> The Oversight Board has determined that its conflict of interest code does not require amendments at the biennial review, and directs the Board Secretary to file the 2016 Local Agency Biennial Notice (Exhibit A) with the City Council not later than October 1, 2016.
