Commission discussion included: Treasurer's role in collaborating with United American Capital Corporation (UACC), the City's contracted investment management firm; bond interest rates; and Pooled Investment Portfolio balances in relation to volume of activity and fund balances.

Commission discussion included: the current Broker Dealer list in use and the impact of the proposed modification; background and history for implementing the current Broker Dealer qualification process; follow up reporting on the impact of the change; the reason the City does not use private sector placement; and a request for information on the role and responsibility of the City's investment management firm.
