

PROHIBITED SIGNS AND BANNERS

PROHIBITED SIGNS

- Flags, banners or pennants, used for advertising purpose (Section 7-2-3 Zoning Code).
- Signs on or affixed to trucks, automobiles, trailers or other vehicles which advertise, identify or provide direction to a use or activity (Section 7-2-3 Zoning Code).
- Signs on public property top include utility poles, traffic sign posts, streets and public right of way (Section 7-2-3 Zoning Code).

REAL ESTATE SIGN RESTRICTIONS (ON-SITE)

COMMERCIAL/INDUSTRIAL AREAS: Maximum 18 square feet in area, five feet maximum height for ground signs (Section 7-3-3 Zoning Code, sign type 104).

RESIDENTIAL AREAS: Maximum six square feet in area, four feet maximum height for ground signs (Section 7-3-3 Zoning Code, sign type 105).

CONVENIENCE SIGN RESTRICTIONS

CONTRACTOR SIGNS: Maximum 32 square feet in area on - contractor's trailer but not above the roof, on gate of construction fence but not above top of fence (Section 7-3-3 Zoning Code, sign type 109).

SIGNS PERMITTED

- Signs approved under City approved sign program through the Department of Community Development.
- Signs where a permit has been issued, installation and inspection completed, where required.

Violations of the above regulations are unlawful.
