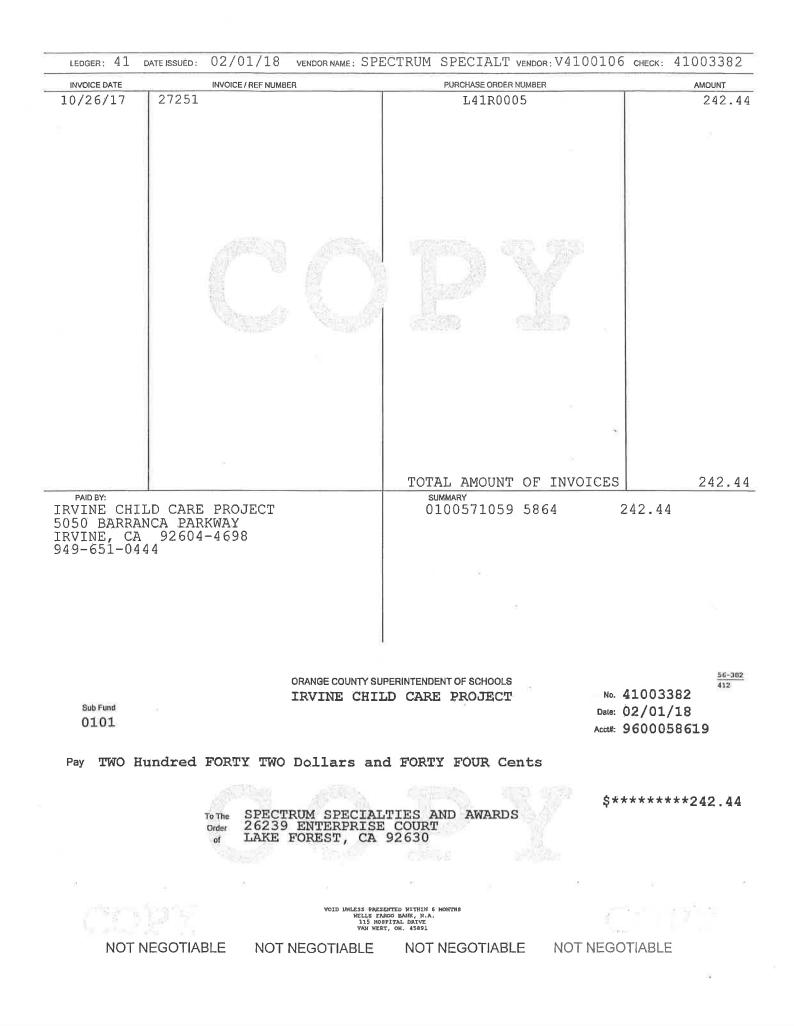

ICCP Administrator's Report

Irvine Child Care Project (ICCP) Administrator's Report March 12, 2018

Scholarships/Financial Assistance:

- Please plan to attend the annual Irvine Junior Games on May 6, 2018. Over 1,200 IUSD athletes, grades 4-8, will participate in a track meet to raise funds for scholarships for children attending ICCP programs.
- Staff is researching options for income eligible families unable to access care at impacted sites.

Program Quality:

- Cadence Park School provider selection process is open and proposals are due on March 15, 2018. The selection panel will consist of Darin Loughrey, ICCP Board President; Stan Machesky, Irvine Unified School District (IUSD) representative; Carlo Grasso, Cadence Park School Principal; Julie DeLorenzo and Julie Bookwalter, Program Assessment and Review Committee (PARC) members; and Jade Yang, Irvine Child Care Committee member along with one Cadence Park parent and one Cadence Park teacher representative. Supervisor Stubbler will coordinate the process and observe the interviews.
- Spring Directors' Forum February 22, 2018 "Emergency Planning and Preparedness" presented by: Henrie Watkins, Specialized Safety Services. All 26 sites were represented with 55 Directors and Assistant Directors in attendance. Participants received information and learned techniques for assisting groups in an emergency and participated in hands-on practice exercises.
- On February 22, 2018 IUSD hosted a Transitional Kindergarten (TK) Parent Information Night at Beacon Park School. The event provided information to parents of children who turn 5 between September 2 and December 2, 2018 about the IUSD Transitional Kindergarten Program and enrollment procedures. Representatives from Child Development Centers, Inc., Rainbow Rising and Kids Stuff (the ICCP providers at the IUSD schools designated to offer a TK program) to answer questions about child care for families.
- Completed Principal Questionnaire forms from all 26 sites will be provided to the Board at the May 14 meeting.

Facilities:

- Spring and Summer Relocation Sites:
 - Due to decline in summer enrollment and construction on some campuses the following programs will be relocated to alternative campuses:
 - Bonita Canyon Rainbow Rising will combine with Alderwood Rainbow Rising for both Spring and Summer break.
 - Brywood Kids Stuff will be moved to the Westpark Elementary campus beginning summer 2018 through summer 2019.
 - Meadow Park Rainbow Rising will be closed summer 2018 through summer 2019. The program will be moved to the El Camino campus beginning August 23, 2018. Alternative location(s) for summer 2018 care under review.
- ICCP Site expansion summer 2018: Eastshore Dolphin Club, Stonegate Child Development Center and Portola Springs Rainbow Rising. Supervisor Stubbler attended Dolphin Club Board Meeting on February 13, 2018 to clarify Dolphin Club and ICCP responsibilities. Each agency is preparing for the expansion through development of budget, recruitment and training timeline, and a communication plan with wait list families.
- Construction to take place on the Westpark, College Park and Canyon View campuses beginning summer 2018. ICCP facilitating logistics coordination between providers, IUSD Facilities and Construction and Community Care Licensing.
