



# Transportation Impacts Workshop

## Vehicle Miles Traveled – SB 743

The City of Irvine is updating its California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) Manual to comply with the State's updated CEQA Guidelines that became effective on December 28, 2018. In particular, the City's Traffic Impact Analysis Guidelines will be updated to address new requirements under Senate Bill (SB) 743 for analyzing transportation impacts using Vehicle Miles Traveled (VMT) for CEQA mitigation purposes. All California cities must develop and use VMT as their primary metric of transportation impact under CEQA by July 1, 2020.

This second and last workshop will review the City's proposed draft screening criteria, VMT analysis methodology, significance thresholds, and VMT mitigation methodology. Refinements have been made based on feedback received from the first stakeholder workshop. Additionally, the workshop will introduce the redlined traffic impact analysis guidelines. This workshop will also offer the opportunity for participants to ask questions and offer input. This event is open to the public.
