






PLANNING OUR FUTURE



- The Irvine General Plan is the City's master plan for its development, improvement, and preservation.
- State law requires all communities in California to prepare a general plan to guide long-term development.
- Irvine incorporated in 1971, the City adopted its first general plan in 1972, with subsequent updates over time.



WHY UPDATE THE PLAN



- Since the last major update of the plan in 1999, Irvine has continued to mature.
 _Annexed 20 square miles
 _Population increase of 100,000+
- State laws have also significantly changed; general plans must be updated to keep pace with changing regulations.
- As community needs change, priorities and services must be adapted to maintain and improve quality of life.






A GENERAL PLAN IS NOT



- A General Plan is not the same as design guidelines for specific development.
- General Plans are not the same as zoning, which regulate uses of a specific parcel. The general plan covers the entire city.
- General Plans are not short-range plans, but instead address long-term planning of a city (a 15 to 20-year period).



USING THE GENERAL PLAN



The General Plan is used in many ways

- By the City, to guide decisions, prioritize services, and plan improvements
- By developers, to build new projects and amenities to serve the community
- By agencies, to understand key needs of the community and plan for services
- By residents, to provide input on policies and programs to improve quality of life




