Job Assignment: Kitchen Assistant Dishwasher

Duties:

- Wash hands immediately before starting duties in the kitchen
- Clean prep areas, equipment and dishes used for food prep and lunch service

Hours: Monday, Wednesday & Fridays from 11a.m.–2 p.m.

Skills, Abilities and Knowledge:

Must be able to walk and stand for long periods of time

Dress Code:

- T-Shirts, closed toed shoes; Jeans (no holes) or <u>knee-length shorts</u> that you don't mind getting dirty
- Long hair must be pulled back into a ponytail or bun; a hairnet or hat must be worn when in the kitchen.
- No perfume or cologne when working in the kitchen
- Beard nets are required for facial hair beards, mustaches and goatees

Training:

Hands on training will be provided by the Kitchen Manager

Qualifications:

- Once a week commitment for a minimum of 3-6 months
- Age 18 years or older
