Venta Spur Trail Crossings Improvement Project

The Venta Spur Trail Crossings Improvement Project will review street crossings along the trail that do not have a traffic signal. The goal of the project is to identify opportunities to improve safety and accessibility for all users.

Stretching 3.7 miles, the Venta Spur Trail follows the route of a former railroad spur that once served packing houses on the historic Irvine Ranch. Today, the trail serves as an important connection to the City’s past as well as a vital part of Irvine’s vast trail network.

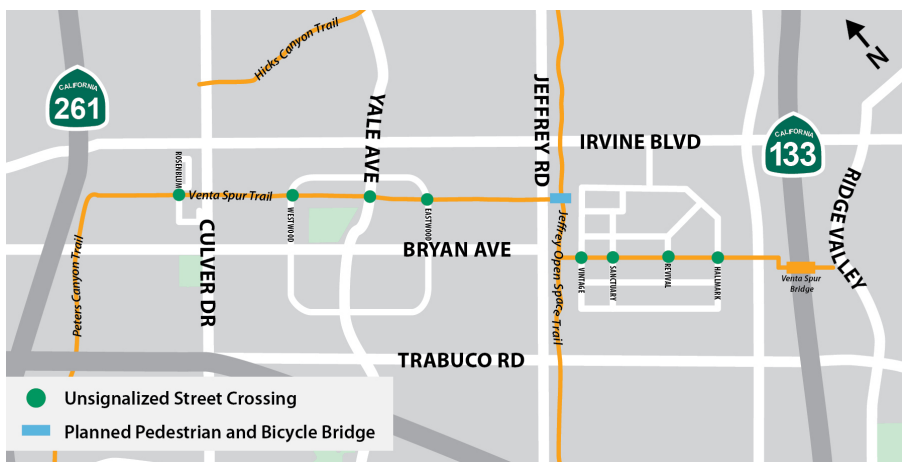
